

A BABY'S CRY

Exodus 2:5-6a

Soon after this, one of Pharaoh's daughters came down to bathe in the river, and her servant girls walked along the riverbank. When the princess saw the little basket among the reeds, she told one of her servant girls to get it for her. As the princess opened it, she found the baby boy. His helpless cries touched her heart.

1. Do not fear. God is working.

A. God works in ways we do not anticipate

1. Jesus came as a commoner

2. The future may crumble our well-laid plans. We may not anticipate it, But God has.

B. God works in ways we cannot see.

John 3:8

C. God works in ways we do not understand

Isaiah 55:8-11

2. Do not fear. God's nature guarantees his interest, concern, and action.

A. God by nature takes the initiative

1. Creation *ex nihilo*

2. Initiated the covenant relationship with Abraham,

3. Delivered the Israelites from Egypt. Moses was just one more link in the divinely forged chain.

4. Provided salvation through Jesus Christ.

5. Sent the Holy Spirit

That he should sit passively by while his children call upon him is unthinkable.”

B. God is our father

Matthew 7:9-11

Because He knows us and loves us, *we never need to be afraid of the answers that He gives.*

C. God continually is at work in those who are willing

Philippians 2:13

We must accept His help

D. God wants to work in and through us

Isaiah 65:1

Take heart, give God your life. Trust Him

Have you asked Him to help you? Then He is!

Even if you cannot see Him, He's with you.

Even if you cannot feel Him, He's there.
